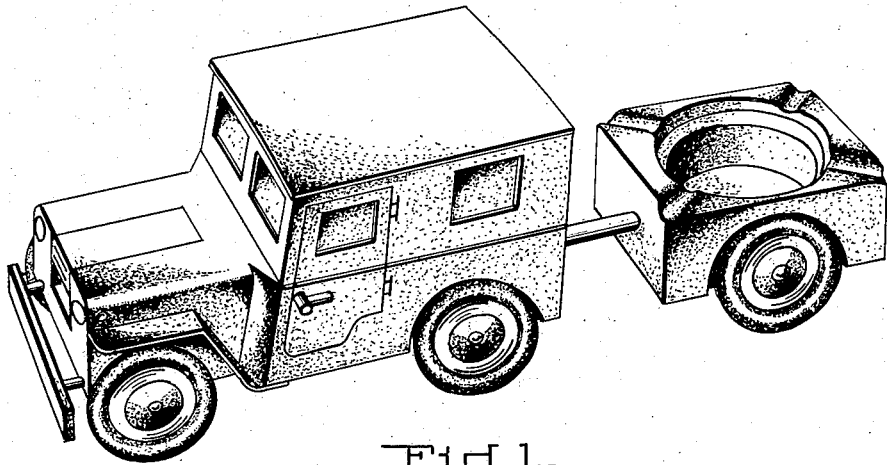

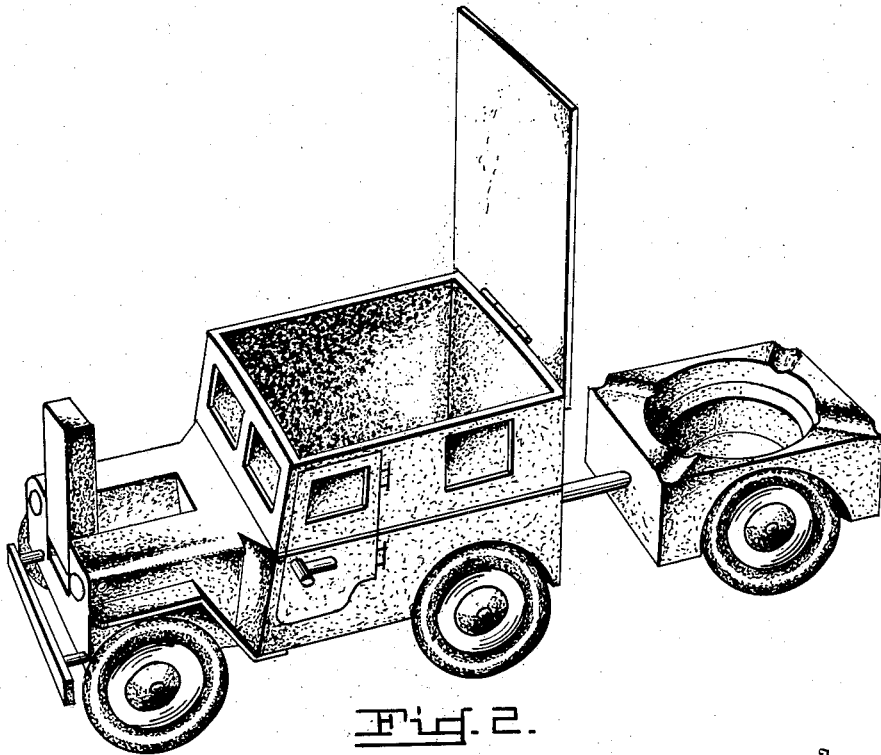

DESIGN FOR A COMBINATION LIGHTER, CIGARETTE RECEPTACLE, AND ASH TRAY

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Walter Baier, a citizen of the German Reich, residing at Wuerttemberg, United States Zone, Germany, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combination Lighter, Cigarette Receptacle, and Ash Tray, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a combination lighter, cigarette receptacle, and ash tray, showing my new design, the lighter and receptacle in closed position.

Fig. 2 is a perspective view thereof, the lighter and receptacle being in open position.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a combination

lighter, cigarette receptacle, and ash tray, substantially as shown.
