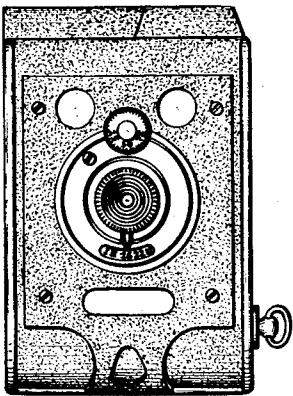

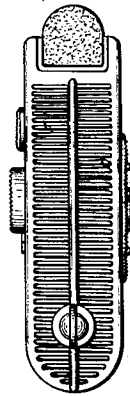
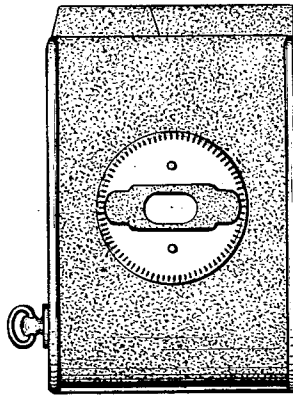

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known, that I, Martin Grünstein, a citizen of Germany, residing at Elgersburg, Thuringia, Germany, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pocket Lighter, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
